## PERFORMANCE LINKED INCENTIVE

An incentive of **15%** of the advertised stakes will be given to Owners of horses finishing first, second and third during the Pune Meeting 2009. This will be payable only for non-sponsored races where the total stakes do not exceed Rs.3.10 lakhs.

These incentives are only for Western India based horses and not for outstation horses. Further there would be no deduction by way of trainers' or jockeys' commission or any other deduction from this performance linked incentive payable to Owners.

**RE: NORMS PERTAINING TO OUTSTATION HORSES  
COMING TO RACE IN WESTERN INDIA**

1. A 2 year-old horse entering in training in Western India will pay Rs.12,000/- as Arrival charges provided that the horse is physically present in Western India or is in the list of expected 2-year-old horses supplied by the Trainer on or before 10<sup>th</sup> April 2009 as per the notice dated 19<sup>th</sup> March 09. If a horse arrives in Western India after 10<sup>th</sup> April 2009, for which no intimation was received by 10<sup>th</sup> April 2009, as stated above, then such a horse will be allowed to come to Western India on a payment of Rs.20,000/-, provided Stables are available to accommodate such horse/s both in Mumbai and Pune.
2. A 2 year - old horse, as per the list above, must be physically present at the Mumbai Racecourse to participate during the Mumbai Meeting by 15<sup>th</sup> November 2009, otherwise Rs.20,000 per horse will be charged as Arrival charges. Further, if horse/s mentioned in the List of expected 2-year-old horses supplied by the Trainer/s, do not arrive by 15<sup>th</sup> November 2009 at the latest, the Trainer will be penalized.
3. If the Arrival charge has been paid in respect of a horse, the horse can come back to Western India for racing, provided the Trainer taking charge of the horse has Stabling facility for the said horse.
4. It is clarified that the aforesaid Arrival charges of Rs. 12,000/- and Rs. 20,000/- are a charge for permitting the two year-old to race in Western India only for such time and up to such age as fixed and decided by the Stewards of the Club, at their sole discretion from time to time and no right of whatsoever nature, (including right for stable accommodation), shall be deemed to be

created in favour of any person by virtue of the arrival charges imposed by the Club as aforesaid.

**OUTSTATION HORSE/S:**

5. Outstation horse/s will be required to pay the Arrival Charges of Rs.12,000/- per Racing Season. Outstation horses will only be allowed to race in Classic/ Graded and/ or Million race/s and the races listed below:

The Akkasaheb Maharaj Trophy.  
The Nirmal Ruia Gold Trophy.

And any other race/s that the Stewards may identify.

Outstation horses shall not be permitted to race in races for 2/3 year old horses, except the Graded and Million race/s for that age-group. Outstation horses entered and/ or Left-in in the Classic/ Graded or Million race/s to be run during the Pune Meeting 2009 will be permitted to participate in **ONLY ONE PREPARATORY RACE.**

6. There will be 12 stalls earmarked for Outstation horses. Request for allotment of Stables for the Outstation horse will have to be made, in writing, by the Trainer concerned, well in advance. Priority will be given to:
  - a. Horses entered for the Classic races.
  - b. Horses entered for Graded races.
7. A Western India Trainer shall only be allowed to stable an Outstation horse in his yard provided that he has vacant Stables. These horses can be attended to by his local Syces.
8. The Western India Trainer taking charge of Outstation horse/s shall be solely and entirely responsible for any positive finding of a prohibited substance.

9. An Outstation horse entered for a race must be present on the premises of the RWITC Ltd to participate in a race before the time specified for the Acceptances, unless advance intimation, in writing, is received from the Trainer concerned regarding the arrival date of the horse. An Outstation Trainer must state in advance the name of races he wishes to race his charge during the Meeting and when the horse/s would leave station.
10. Syces of Outstation horse/s may look after that horse if the horse is housed in the Stables reserved for Outstation horses and a Western India Trainer may look after the said horse/s on behalf of the original Trainer.
11. Horses rated below 40 points by the RWITC Ltd Handicapper, shall not be allotted stables.
12. In case, an Outstation horse arrives in Pune but fails to race TWICE during the Pune Meeting 2009, charges as detailed below will be debited to the account of the Owner/s concerned:  
If the horse does not race at all - Rs.25,000/-  
If the horse races only once - Rs.12,500/-.

**PRESENCE OF A HORSE ON THE CLUB'S PREMISES.**  
**ENTERED FOR A RACE**

The Stewards of the Club at their Meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2007 have decided that an Out-station horse must be present on the premises of this Club to participate in a race for which the horse is duly entered, before the time specified for the Acceptances, unless an advance intimation, in writing, is received from the Trainer concerned regarding the arrival date and time of the horse.

Due to non-compliance of any of the conditions mentioned above, the concerned horse will be struck out at the Acceptance stage and the Trainer may be fined, at the discretion of the Stewards.

## NOTICE

### **RE: GUIDELINES FOR MOVEMENT OF THOROUGHBRED HORSES INTO R.W.I.T.C.LTD AT MUMBAI/ PUNE**

All concerned may kindly note that:

A. All thorough-bred horses arriving at RWITC Ltd Mumbai/ Pune from the Stud Farms/ Turf Authorities located in Glanders free States should possess the following documents:

1. Passport;
2. Valid EIA Certificate;
3. A Health Certificate from the Senior/ Chief Veterinary Officer where the horse last raced stating that the horse neither suffered nor showed any signs of infectious diseases like EIA, Glanders, African Horse Sickness and Dourine.

B. All thorough-bred horses arriving at RWITC Ltd from the Stud Farms/ Turf Authorities located in States where Glanders is either reported or notified should possess the following documents:

1. Passport;
2. Valid EIA Certificate;
3. CFT Glanders Certificate from DRL, Pune or NRCE, Hissar (Validity period – 30 days).
4. In case a horse is arriving from a Stud farm – A Certificate from Deputy Director/ Joint Director of Animal Husbandry Department of that location stating that there is No Glanders cases in that Stud Farm and also within the vicinity of 25 kms from the Stud Farm.
5. In case a horse is arriving from another Turf Authority - A Health Certificate from the Senior/ Chief

Veterinary Officer where the horse last raced stating that the horse neither suffered nor showed any signs of infectious diseases like EIA, Glanders, African Horse Sickness and Dourine.

C. All thoroughbred horses arriving at RWITC Ltd from the Stud Farms/ Turf Authorities should be administered with primary course of approved vaccinations against Equine Influenza comprising of at least two doses given in accordance with the manufacturers recommendation but not within 14 days of departure and bearing the Vaccination Certificate with the details of Date of Vaccination, Name of Vaccine, Batch number and Expiry date and duly signed by either Chief Veterinarian of the Stud Farm or Panel Veterinarian only and duly endorsed in the Passport. Turf Authorities of India is permitting the use of Fluvac Innovator or Proteq Flu.

However if the Senior Veterinary Officer of a Turf Club certifies that a particular horse had suffered from Equine Influenza, then that horse shall be exempted from vaccination for a period of 6 months from the date of onset of clinical signs of Equine Influenza.

- D. The onus would be on the Trainer concerned to ascertain from the RWITC Ltd in advance of the documents required.
- E. Horses without necessary Certificate/ Passport Endorsement will not be permitted to enter the race course under any circumstances.
- F. The Stewards may impose any fine or penalty for the breach of these Rules at their discretion.

1. The Stewards reserve the right to amend or alter any of the Clause/s contained in the General Conditions of this Prospectus, if the circumstances so warrant.

2. All entries must be accompanied by a remittance for the full amount of such entries or they will be declined.

(a) When a remittance is made to the Secretary without specifying the way in which it is to be applied, the money will be credited to the race/s in the order of the program.

(b) Cheques and drafts must be made payable in Mumbai in favour of the Secretary, R.W.I.T.C., Ltd., and not to any one by name.

(c) Entry must be made by the Owner or by a person duly authorized by him, in writing, in accordance with Rules 72, 83 and 84 of Rules of Racing.

(d) **Horses eligible in two Classes are the ones rated as under:**

**NOTE: Ratings are in points and each point is equal to half-a-kilo.**

(e) Entry must be made on forms, which will be supplied by the Secretary on application.

A horse may be entered in race/s, where it is eligible on the same day; however, such horse may be **accepted to run in not more than one race on that day**. Except in handicaps, the correct weight of any horse not struck out must be notified in writing to the Secretary not later than the date and time published for final forfeits. In races where no such final forfeits are advertised, correct weights must be declared in the entry form not later than the date and time published for closing of entries. The person responsible for failing to comply with these General Conditions will be fined.

(f) The Stewards reserve the right to refuse or cancel any entry at any time without assigning any reason.

(g) The Stewards will refuse all entries made by or on behalf of any Owner who is not of the age of majority according to the law to which he is subject.

(h) The Stewards reserve the right to alter the date of or abandon any race or meeting owing to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

(i) The Stewards reserve the right to amend or alter the conditions of any race at any time before the closing time of entries.

(j) I (i) In races below 1800 meters, other than races for Class I (horses rated 80 and upwards, Class II (horses rated 60 to 86) and Sweepstake races, if there are **less than 7 (seven) entries in bonafide separate interests**, such race/s shall be declared void.

In races below 1800 meters, for Class I (horses rated 80 and upward) and Class II (horses rated 60 to 86) only, if there are **less**

**than 5 (five) entries in bonafide separate interests**, such race/s shall be declared void.

In races of 1800 metres and over, in any Class, other than Sweepstake races, if there are **less than 4 (four) entries in bonafide separate interests**, such race/s shall be declared void.

**(ii) ALL ACCEPTORS MUST RUN IN ALL RACES.**

(iii) In case of **morning race days**, no race will be divided **except those for 2/3-year-old horses**. In the event of there being excess number of acceptors over the prescribed safety limit of the Track, the excess number of acceptors shall be balloted out.

(iv) There shall not be more than two divisions of any race in case of a division at the acceptance stage. In the event of there being excess number of acceptors over the prescribed limit of the track for either or both divisions, the excess number of acceptors shall be balloted out prior to the division being made. **Trainers of acceptors in such races are requested to be present when balloting takes place.**

(v) A horse accepted in more than one race for the races to be held on the same day, the Handicapper will have the right to scratch out the horse from one of the two races, at the Acceptance stage. If such a horse has accepted in both Handicap races or both terms races, then it would be struck out from the second of the two races for which it has been accepted, in the order of the races as published in the handicaps. If a horse has been accepted in a handicap race and a terms race, then it shall be struck out from the handicap race.

(vi) The procedure for division of race/s will be as under:

a) Division of Handicap Races: -

The procedure of allocating horses in to divisions will be as under:

For example, if a race is left with 20 acceptors; the horses in each division will be allocated as under:

1. If the acceptors are 20, 10 horses will be assigned to each division.
2. If all the horses belong to different Owner/ Trainer, the first 10 horses will be assigned to Division I and the remaining 10 acceptors will be in Division II.
3. If any Owner or Trainer has two horses accepted, the higher weighted/ rated horse will be allocated to Division I and the lower weighted/ rated horse will be in Division II.
4. After separating the horses belonging to the same Owner/ Trainer, the balance number of horses required for a particular Division will be allocated starting from the top weighted horse, till the required number of horses for that particular Division is met.
5. The same method will apply when any Owner or Trainer has 3 horses accepted in a race with the highest weighted horse falling in the Division I and the lowest weighted being allocated in Division II and the third horse will take its place in any of the two Divisions as per its weight.
6. If an Owner/ Trainer has 4 horses accepted in a race, the 2 highest weighted horses will be in Division I and the 2 lowest weighted horses will be in Division II.
7. If an Owner has more than one acceptors and one of these acceptors is in the charge of a Trainer who also has two acceptors, then such horses will be “grouped” and the highest weighted horse amongst these will be allocated in Division I whilst the other horses will be separated as per the procedure stated in the above Clauses.

b) Division of 2/3 years old Terms Races: -

In the event of a race/s being divided into two divisions at acceptance stage, the acceptors in each division shall be determined by lot. Horses in the nomination of the same Owner or in the care of the same Trainer shall be separated. In case of three or more such nominations, the exchange shall be determined by lot.

(vii) MINIMUM NUMBER OF ACCEPTORS IN RACE/S,  
OTHER THAN SWEEPSTAKE RACES:

- a) **There shall be a minimum of 7 acceptors in all races, except in Class I (horses rated 80 and upwards) and Class II (horses rated 60 to 86) and races that are 1800 metres and over.**
- b) **In races below 1800 metres in Class I (horses rated 80 and upwards) and Class II (horses rated 60 to 86), if the numbers of acceptors are less than 5 (five), such race/s shall be declared void.**
- c) **In races of 1800 metres and over, in all Classes, if there are less than 4 (four) acceptors, such race/s shall be declared void.**

(viii) Any acceptor/s once balloted out from a race, except for a Sweepstake race, shall not be included for ballot in a subsequent race wherein it is an acceptor. Except for Sweepstake races, the entry fee in respect of horse/s balloted out will be refunded.

(ix) In the event of the entries for the next Race Day/s are closing on the day acceptances are held then only those horses which are balloted-out at the acceptance stage may be entered for the next race day/s but not later than 12.00 noon for the entries which are advertised to close at 10.30 a.m. on that day.

(II) RACES WITH CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS STAKES / SWEEPSTAKE RACES.

a) **NO SWEEPSTAKE RACE WILL BE DECLARED VOID AFTER THE ENTRY STAGE.** In case the numbers of acceptors exceed the prescribed Track limit, the excess number of acceptors will be balloted out as per the conditions of the race or as per clause below.

b) If the number of runners in any such race is in excess of the safety limit, rejection will be based on the aggregate value of Winner's stakes only that has been won by the horse after 30<sup>th</sup> April 2007, in ascending order starting from the horse which has earned the lowest aggregate stakes. In case of a tie, wherever applicable, the horse/s to be rejected will be determined by ballot.

c) In Sweepstake races confined to maidens, rejection will be by ballot.

d) Only the Final Forfeit amount would be refundable in respect of any horse/s having been rejected from a Sweepstake race.

e) Any race with contribution towards stakes / sweepstake race may be divided, at the absolute discretion of the Stewards, provided the second race formed by such division finds a contributor who will put in the entire money equivalent to the total prize from the race Fund plus the original contributor's offer for the original race including Trophy. In the event such a new race is formed then the entry fees/ forfeits paid in by non-acceptors shall be divided equally between the two races.

It is also clarified that the second race formed after such division can be named as per the wishes of the contributor of that division. No race with contribution towards stakes shall be split into more than two divisions as specified above.

**f) Division of Race/s, other than Sweepstake race/s, will be as under: -**

i) Division of Race/s shall be made only if the number of acceptors in any race are or exceed 17 (Seventeen) for all races.

ii) In all races including divided races, excess number of acceptors beyond 17 (Seventeen) shall be balloted out or the race will be divided as per the Rule in force. A horse once balloted out will not be excluded by ballot for the next occasion for which it is an acceptor.

**g) Norms for reframing of races which may be declared void:**

There shall usually be a minimum of 7 (seven) races on a Race Day and 8 (eight) on a Classic, Graded or Million Race Day that are held on Sundays. No void race/s need be reframed if the criteria of the minimum number of races on a Race Day are met.

In order to meet the criteria of minimum number of races per Race Day as advertised, the void races shall be usually reframed (but not compulsorily) with the same conditions with fresh entries. Priority will be given to reframe races with the maximum number of acceptors (which were declared void) first. **The entries for such newly framed race/s would close at 4.00 p.m. on the Day of the Acceptances.**

(III) Races where the Trophies are donated will also be divided at the acceptance stage provided there are the requisite numbers of acceptors. However, the Stewards retain the right to reduce the Trophy value in the lower division at their absolute discretion.

(k) In the event of a horse being entered for a race for horses qualified in a certain way and should such horse become ineligible owing to winning or transfer to another Class after the date of entry, the entry fee for any race for which a horse so becomes ineligible will be refunded.

Should a horse becomes eligible after the closing of the entries, the horse can be entered on date and time the entries for the Day close.

(l) The accepting of entries for all races advertised in this Prospectus is subject to the following two conditions, namely  
(i) That the Stewards reserve the right in connection with any race or races, should the conditions existing at any time so warrant, to cancel at their absolute discretion any race or races at any time before the actual running of the race or races and  
(ii) The Stewards reserve the right in connection with any race or races, should the conditions existing at any time so warrant, **TO REDUCE AT THEIR ABSOLUTE DISCRETION, THE AMOUNT/S OF THE PRIZE MONEY, entrance, forfeits and any other fees advertised to such extent as they may think fit before the closing time fixed by them for accepting the entries.**

If the Stewards decide to cancel and/or alter a race with contribution towards stake on account of non-payment of the contribution agreed to by the concerned contributor, the Stewards shall be entitled to reduce the stake money for the concerned race, as they may in their discretion deem fit under the circumstances.

(m) Special attention is drawn to Rule 41 (g) of the Rules of Racing, which reads as follows: -

“41. The Stewards of the Club have power at their discretion:-

(g) To order the advancement or cancellation or abandonment or postponement of any race or Race Meeting and to sanction additional dates or frame new races for any Meeting and to make all such arrangements for the Meeting as they may at their sole discretion think fit.”

3A.(a) No horse shall be entered in any race other than those for the Class in which it is rated by the R.W.I.T.C., Ltd. Handicapper, unless otherwise mentioned in the conditions of the race.

(b) Horses which have raced at Meetings other than those conducted under the Rules of R.W.I.T.C. Ltd subsequent to it being given a rating by the R.W.I.T.C., Ltd. Handicapper must be applied for re-rating to the R.W.I.T.C. Ltd Handicapper prior to entry for races under these Rules. Entries of any horse for which application for re-rating has not been received, may be refused or cancelled.

(c) In the event of a horse having raced at a Meeting other than under the R.W.I.T.C. Ltd Rules of Racing subsequent to its having been entered for a race under R.W.I.T.C. Ltd Rules, the entries of such horse will be void unless an application for re-rating is received and the horse is rated prior to the closing of Final Entries for the race for which it is entered.

(d) In the event of a horse having raced at a Meeting other than under R.W.I.T.C., Ltd Rules of Racing subsequent to having been handicapped under R.W.I.T.C. Ltd Rules, such horse shall be withdrawn from the race even after it having been accepted or declared to start.

**(e) All Trainers are hereby informed that a race for which entries have closed, no change in Class with rating will be permitted at the request of the Owner/Trainer to enable that horse to be entered.**

3B. Foreign rigs are not permitted to run in races at Mumbai and Pune.

Re: Foreign Geldings, attention is drawn to the Notice published in the Racing Calendar, which reads as follows:-

“Owners and Trainers are informed that horses imported into this county not as entires but as geldings are not eligible at all to be entered for and to run in any race in Mumbai or Pune in accordance with the terms of the License to Race granted by the State Government.

Horses imported into this country as entires but subsequently gelded will however be permitted to be entered for and to run in races for which they may otherwise be eligible except such races by the conditions whereof they are expressly precluded from doing so.”

4(a) A horse may be transferred by the Handicapper from one Class to another in accordance with Rule 81, Rules of Racing.

**(b) In all Handicaps, the lowest weight to be carried shall not be less than 49 kg, excluding the allowance that a Jockey may**

**claim. However, the handicaps may be framed down to weights below 49 kg**

In all handicaps, the minimum top weight to be carried shall be 59 kg, though the Handicapper may handicap horses higher than this minimum top weight as per their ratings, weights shall be raised up to 59 kg only (unless specifically provided otherwise) in the event the top weighted acceptor is below 59 kg

In all handicap races, unless the terms of the race specify otherwise, when the top weight exceeds 59 kg, (the lowest permissible top weight) and the bottom weight is above 50 kg, the weights will be lowered at Handicap stage to the extent where the bottom weight does not go below 50 kg. In case there is a horse handicapped at 50 kg the weights would not be lowered.

**5.** No entry will be received for any race except upon condition that it is subject to the Rules of Racing of the Royal Western India Turf Club, Ltd., and the General Conditions as published in this Prospectus and that all disputes, claims and objections arising out of such entry and/or the start and/or the running and/or the result of the race as in all other races under the Rules of the Club shall be decided by the Stewards and that their authority shall be supreme and their decision shall be final and shall not be liable to be questioned in any Court of Law.

#### **TIME OF STARTING DECLARATION**

**6A.** Unless otherwise specified, Starting Declarations for each race must be in the Declaration Box set apart for that race (in the Weighing Room) at or before 8.30 a.m. on the day preceding the race day.

The Declaration must be in writing and signed by the Owner or his Authorized Agent, on an official form, which will be supplied by the Secretary, and must state the name of the race, the name of the horse and weight to be carried, and the name of the Jockey. **It shall**

**also state if the horse is running shod or unshod; if the former, it shall state the description of plates or tips used.**

Trainers will be held responsible for correctly filling in the column regarding shoeing.

Omissions or errors in the Starting Declaration will render the owner or person making the Declaration subject to a fine at the discretion of the Stewards.

**B.** No person shall be declared to ride in a race who, at the time of Declaration, does not hold a valid license under the Rules of this Club. However, a jockey who has been suspended can be declared to ride in a race provided his suspension is over at the time of the race.

Before the name of the rider is declared in the Starting Declaration, it shall be the duty of the person making the Declaration, to ascertain first whether such rider holds a valid license to ride in races under R.W.I.T.C., Ltd Rules of Racing and further that such rider is qualified to ride in the race in which he is declared to ride. Also, that such Jockey is free of any other riding engagement in that race. Any infringement of this General Condition will be severely dealt with.

**C.** In the event of a Race Day being postponed due to unavoidable circumstances, the Starting Declarations already placed in the boxes will be treated as cancelled and fresh Starting Declarations for the postponed Race Day will be required to be deposited.

**7.** All horses running in a race must be brought into the Paddock within a reasonable time. In the case of any horse brought late into the Paddock, the Trainer concerned will render himself liable to a fine.

8. Except as hereinafter provided, every person running a horse in colours other than those registered in his name, will be fined. Where colours are not registered, a declaration must be made of the colours to be used not later than 10 a.m. 2 days prior to the race; otherwise a fine will be imposed.

**In the event of a person is unable to run a horse in colours as declared in the Official Race Card, the Jockey will wear “All Black”. A set of these colours may be obtained from the Clerk of the Scales.**

9. In all handicaps, Winner of a race, after the publication of weights, to carry 6 kg extra. This Rule shall also be applicable to any handicap race/s, which have conditions, whereby the top weight is not to exceed a specified weight in the original handicap.

10. An Owner or Trainer who desires that his horse carry an overweight in races is permitted to do so.

a) If the intended overweight is up to 1.5 kg over the published weight, no prior permission is needed.

b) If the intended overweight is above 1.5 kg and up to 3.5 kg over the published weight, prior permission must be obtained before the start of the first race of the Day.

c) If the intended overweight is more than 3.5 kg over the published weight, prior permission must be obtained before Declaration Stage; the rider or his substitute shall carry the overweight so permitted.

When prior permission is required to be obtained to carry an overweight but is not obtained, the Trainer and/ or Jockey responsible will be liable for disciplinary action, at the discretion of the Stewards.

11. Owners whose entries for the Pune Meeting amount to more than the price of a Season Coupon Book will receive a ticket for the Pune Meeting. For part owners, the entries must amount to more than double the price of a Season Coupon Book. Other owners will receive a day ticket only for the day on which their horses are engaged to run.

**Owners' Tickets are not transferable.**

12. **Definition of Sweepstakes**-A “Sweepstakes” is a race in which stakes are made by the owners of three or more horses engaged to be paid to the winner or placed horses and any such race is a Sweepstakes when money or other prize is added.

In case the number of runners is less than the number of prize money offered, for subsequent places, the balance amount will be distributed between the winner and those placed horses in the same proportion of percentage as specified in the Prospectus for that race to the winner and placed horses.

**Definition of Breeder**—the “Breeder” is a person who owns the dam when the foal is dropped.

**N.B.**—Under no circumstances will any refund of Entry fee and/or Forfeits be granted for any horse/s prohibited from running in a race on veterinary grounds.

13. As per directions of the Committee of the Club, 10% of Win & Place commissions earned by visiting trainers at this Center, will be deducted and credited to the Trainers' Benevolent Fund account.

14. 2½ % of stakes earned by Owners from horses placed first, second, third and fourth will be deducted from the Owners account and be credited to the respective Trainers' accounts for onward transfer to The Race Stable Workers' Welfare and Research

Society. This is in lieu of commensurate increment in the Feeding and Upkeep.

**15.** 2% of all stakes earned by the Owners of out-station horses will be deducted and credited to the Club's account to meet extra expenses on infrastructure.

**16. a)** 0.25 % of all stake money earned by Owners would be deducted and kept with the Club, in a separate account, to be utilized for animal welfare. This will be a voluntary contribution from owners.

**b)** 0.5% of all stake money earned by Owners would be deducted which will be credited to the Owners' Association Account. This will be a voluntary contribution from owners.

**17.** At the time of making entries for races, **Trainers of out-station horses** must enter the names of the Owners and their addresses in the prescribed form, failing which the entry fee/forfeits will be debited to the trainer's account.

## NOTICE

The Stewards of the Club at their Meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> October, 1995 under Rule 22 (j) have decided to suspend Rule 120 in respect to Weight for Age Scale as mentioned in the Rules of Racing under Appendix 'A' until further notice.

It was further decided by the Stewards of the Club that horses from other countries including those from the Southern Hemisphere be henceforth classified as foreign horses and such horses would have to concede 8 kg to an Indian horse, regardless of distance of the race and the month of a year in which the race is run.

Furthermore, in races where penalties are incurred, they would be the same for both foreign and Indian horses.

At their 81<sup>st</sup> Annual General Meeting of the Club held on 19<sup>th</sup> December, 1996, it was resolved that Rule 120 of the Rules of Racing of the Club be altered, amended, substituted and/or added to in the following manner:-

Substitute the following for the existing Rule 120 of the Rules of Racing.

“The scale of the weights and allowances in respect thereof shall be fixed by the Committee from time to time in consultation with the Stewards of the Club and the same shall be notified in the Racing Calendar from time to time.”
