1. It is hereby notified for the information of all concerned that all horses arriving at the premises of Bangalore Turf Club Ltd., should possess the following documents without which they will be strictly prohibited from entering the B. T. C. premises:
 - (a) A valid Coggins Test Certificate negative for E. I. A.
 - (b) A health Certificate from the Senior Veterinary Officer of the respective club stating that the horse does not show any clinical signs of E. I. A., Glanders, AHS strangles or Equine Influenza at the time of its departure.
 - (c) An endorsement in the passport to the effect that they have been administered with approved vaccination against Equine Influenza. The details of the vaccination such as Date and Name of the Vaccine, Batch No. and Expiry date (vignette) should be endorsed in the passport and must be duly signed by the Senior Veterinary Officer of the respective club.
2. No horse will be permitted to race during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2017 unless stabled in B.T.C. premises with the prior permission of the Management.
3. As regards local horses (Bangalore based) stables will be provided to horses aged 3 to 8 years rated 00 and above.
4. (a) As regards the visiting horses for Bangalore Summer Meeting 2017, the following category of horses alone are eligible for allotment of stables in order of priority subject to the availability of stables :
 - (i) All 3 and 4 years old that are entered for Bangalore Summer Classic/s 2017 and not struck out till the date of stable allotment.
 - (ii) 3 and 4 years old that are entered for at least THREE Sweepstakes races to be run during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2017.
 - (iii) Horses aged 3 to 8 years rated above 65.
- (b) Visiting horses will not be allowed to participate in races earmarked for horses rated 00 to 20.

- (c) Application for stable accommodation should be submitted on or before 30th April, 2017. However, horses which are eligible will be permitted to enter the B.T.C. premises from 20th March, 2017.
- (d) No Course Fee or Stable Rent will be charged in respect of outstation horses which run at least TWO times during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2017. However, in case a horse fails to complete two runs, service charges as detailed below will be debited to the account of the Owner concerned:

If the horse does not race at all Rs.50,000/-

If the horse runs once Rs.25,000/-

5. Horses aged 9 years old and over will not be permitted to race during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2017, except in Sweepstakes Races.
6. Stables allotted to a particular Owner/Trainer must be occupied only by horses in his charge. Stables applied for and not occupied before the commencement of Bangalore Summer Meeting 2017 will be allotted to other Owners/Trainers without any further notice. No Owner/Trainer will be permitted to sublet the stables allotted to him.
7. Horses on arrival should be produced before the Club's Veterinary Officer and a certificate of soundness obtained.
8. The Club accepts no responsibility for any damage to horses, employees or property whilst in these stables or within the premises.
9. No Entry Fee or Forfeit will be charged in any race except Sweepstakes races. However,
- (a) service charges will be levied as under for horses entered and scratched.
- (i) @ 0.25% of stakes to the winner in case the entry is made only for one race during the week.
- (ii) @ 0.5% of stakes to the winner in each race in case the entry is made for two races during the week.
- (iii) @ 1% of stakes to the winner in each race in case the entry is made for more than two races during the week.

- (b)(i) No service charge will be levied in case the horse is accepted to run in any race if the entry was made for a maximum of two races during the week.
- (ii) Service charge will be levied even if the horse is accepted to run in any race if the entry was made for more than two races during the week as per 9 (a) (iii) above for every additional entry.

Reg : Permission to race at other centres.

- a) No horse will be eligible to participate in any race at any other centre/s except for the race for which permission has been granted.
- b) No horse will be eligible to participate at any other centre/s without running at BTC at least once.
- c) In case a horse temporarily leaves the centre, subsidy will be recovered for the period of absence only, if the period extends beyond one month.

REG : ALLOTMENT OF STABLES TO OUTSTATION HORSES ON A PERMANENT BASIS.

Trainers and Owners are hereby informed that Bangalore Turf Club Ltd., will permit the following category of horses coming from any racing centre in India for allotment of stables on a Permanent basis at Bangalore to participate in Bangalore races:-

- (i) Horses aged 3 years.
- (ii) Horses aged 4 to 6 years rated 50 and above under B.T.C. Rules of Racing.

However, allotment of stables to these horses are subject to the following conditions:

- a) These horses should have entered or guarantee to enter for at least ONE Classic or THREE Sweepstakes races to be run during Bangalore Summer Meeting 2017.
- b) Horses aged 4 years old and over which have not placed first, second, third or fourth in their last ten starts and horses aged 4 years old and over which have not run since 1st May, 2016 will not be considered for allotment of stables.
- c) A maximum of TWENTYFIVE eligible horses will be considered for allotment of stables under the above scheme on a first-come first-serve basis subject to availability of stables.
- d) A maximum of FIVE horses only will be allowed per trainer/owner.
- e) These horses should be under the charge of "A" licensed trainers based in Bangalore. These horses will be permitted strictly within the upper limit of 45 horses per trainer.
- f) These horses will not be permitted to participate at any other centre without running at least once at Bangalore.
- g) These horses will be treated as local horses except that the Owner/Trainer will not be extended any subsidy or incentive in respect of such horses for the first one year.
- h) These horses will be treated as full fledged local horses from 1st May, 2018 and will be extended all the benefits given to local horses thereafter.
- i) A service charge of Rs. 1,00,000/- per horse will be levied on the owner/trainer in case such horse leaves B.T.C premises before 1st May, 2018 or even if the horse fails to participate at least four times exclusively at Bangalore before 31st March, 2018 the above service charge will not be condoned under any circumstance.

- j) Allotment of stables will be at the entire discretion of the management which will be final and binding.
- k) All horses arriving at the premises of Bangalore Turf Club Ltd., should possess the following documents without which they will be strictly prohibited from entering the B.T.C. premises:-
 - (i) A valid Coggins Test Certificate negative for E.I.A.
 - (ii) A health Certificate from the Senior Veterinary Officer of the respective club stating that the horse does not show any clinical signs of E.I.A., Glanders, AHS strangles or Equine Influenza at the time of its departure.

1. All persons taking part in Bangalore Summer Meeting 2017 shall be bound by the Rules of Racing of the B.T.C. and Notifications issued from time to time in the B.T.C. Racing Calendar and such regulations as may be laid down by the Stewards of the Meeting.
2. (a) Unless already registered under B.T.C., R.C.T.C., R.W.I.T.C., M.R.C. , H.R.C. or My.R. C. Rules, horses must be registered under these rules; otherwise entries will be refused.
(b) Application for allotment of rating of a horse already registered must be made to the Secretary, B.T.C. Ltd. at least two days prior to the dates fixed for closing of entries for the respective race days.
When applying for allotment of rating of a horse under B.T.C. Rules of Racing, the applicant must state the date on which and the centre where the horse last raced. If the horse has never raced before, the age and sex must be stated.
3. (a) No horse shall be entered in any race other than those for which it is eligible unless otherwise mentioned in the conditions of the race.
(b) Horses which have raced at Meetings other than those conducted under the B.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to allotment of rating by the B.T.C. Handicapper, must be allotted the rating again by the B.T.C. Handicapper, prior to entry for Handicap races under these Rules. Entries of any horse for a Handicap race for which application for allotment of rating has not been received, may be refused or cancelled.
(c) In the event of a horse having raced at a Meeting other than under the B.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to its having been entered for a Handicap race under B.T.C. Rules, the entries of such horse will be void.
(d) In the event of a horse having raced at a Meeting other than under the B.T.C. Rules of Racing subsequent to having been Handicapped under B.T.C. Rules, such horse shall be withdrawn from the race even after having been Handicapped or Accepted.
4. Before a horse is allowed to start in a race for the first time under B.T.C. Rules of Racing, such horse must be produced before the Club's Veterinary Officer for identification. The responsibility of obtaining a copy of the Certificate of Identity rests with the Owner or Trainer concerned.

5. The dates and times at which Forfeits/Scratchings are advertised to fall due are liable to alteration after the closing of entries, should circumstances arise, which in the opinion of the Stewards, make it desirable. All horses accepting i.e. left in after the time fixed for Final Forfeits/Scratchings must be declared to start unless prior permission for their withdrawal has been obtained from the Stewards. No horse shall be accepted to participate in more than one race on the same day or the following day and when the Handicaps for two days are published on the same day, no horse shall be accepted to participate in more than one race during those two days.

In the event of a horse being left in for more than one race in contravention of the above rule the person responsible for it shall be fined not less than Rs. 10,000/-, but the Owner of such horse shall be permitted to run such horse in any one race of his choice.
6. Owners, Trainers and Jockeys should make themselves familiar with the B.T.C. Track Rules.
7. (a) Unless accompanied by a remittance for the full amount of entrance fees, entries may be refused. If the entries are not signed by the Owner, they must be accompanied by a written authority from the Owner to the enterer, unless such authority has already been registered by B.T.C.
(b) Entries should be made on official forms and correct details of all particulars required in the forms should be filled in.
8. (a) The full advertised prize will be given in every race except in the case of a walk-over when only half the advertised prize will be given subject to the deduction as provided in clause (c) below.
(b) The stakes for the fourth, fifth and sixth placed horses in whichever race these are offered will be given provided there are at least eight, ten and twelve acceptors respectively in that race. However, this rule will not apply to Sweepstakes races.
(c) Stakes/prize money in any race will be credited to the respective Owner/ Trainer /Jockey's account, only after receipt of the analysis of the urine sample of the winner in that race coming clear of any prohibited substance.

- (d) i) One percent of all stakes, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th will be deducted as Owners' Contribution towards the Karnataka Racehorse Owners' Association.
- ii) Two percent of all stakes, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th will be deducted as Owners' contribution in favour of Bangalore Stable Employees' Welfare Society.
- iii) Half percent of all stakes, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th will be deducted as Owners' contribution in favour of Retired Racehorses Welfare Fund.
- iv) Six and half percent of all stakes, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th will be deducted as Owners' contribution in favour of Stable Employees Welfare Fund.
- v) 13.33% of all stakes earned by Jockeys, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th in all races will be deducted as Jockeys' contribution in favour of Jockeys Association of India.
- vi) An amount equivalent to One percent of total stakes to Owners, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th in ordinary races will be contributed to the Jockeys Association of India by the Club.
- vii) An amount equivalent to Half percent of total stakes to Owners, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th in ordinary races will be contributed to the Karnataka Trainers Association by the Club.
- (e) The prizes for lower division race/s, if any, will be the same as for the first division including the trophy. However, value of the Trophy will be given to the Owner/s in respect of lower divisions instead of Trophy.
- (f) In case the Owner/s of the winner wishes to surrender the Trophy to the club in any Cup race excepting Sweepstakes Races, an amount equivalent to the value of the Trophy will be paid. Request for such exchange should be made to the Secretary of the Club with in seven days from the date of running of the relevant race.
- (g) "Any Tax Central/State, liable to be paid on prize money/stakes/cup/trophy is included within the prize money/stakes/cup/trophy respectively and shall be paid by the Owners/Trainers/Jockeys/breeders or any other persons".

9. (a) The Stewards reserve the right, to declare void any race in which there are less than 12 entries in bona fide separate interests.
- (b) The number of races will be restricted to a maximum of eight on Thursdays & Saturdays and nine on Fridays and Sundays.
- (c) Unless otherwise specified if at the time of Final Forfeits/Scratchings there are less than SIX acceptors in bona fide separate interests in a race over a distance of 1600 Metres or more and less than EIGHT acceptors in any other race, such race or races may be declared void at the option of the Stewards.
10. The Stewards may arrange the entrants for any race into two or more divisions and in Handicaps adjust the weights of any division at their discretion. At the time of Final Forfeits/Scratchings, the Stewards may further arrange for a race or a division thereof to be divided on the basis of the weights published.
11. (a) In any race other than a sweepstakes race and races for horses aged 5 years old and over in any category, if the acceptors exceed 12 but not more than 15, then the acceptors in excess of 12 will be eliminated from amongst the horses belonging to Trainer/s and Owner/s (i.e. anyone owner either individually or in a partnership) who have accepted the highest number of horses by applying one or more of the following criteria in that order:-
- (i) Preference of elimination submitted by the Owner/ Trainer if any.
- (ii) Descending order of the age of horses.
- (iii) Descending order of the number of starts of the horses during the meeting.
- (iv) In case of a tie, lots will be drawn.
- This process will be continued till the required number of horses are eliminated.
- (b) In respect of races for horses aged 5 years old and over in any category, if the acceptors exceed 12 but not more than 15, then the acceptors in excess of 12 will be eliminated from amongst the horses belonging to Trainer/s and Owner/s

(i.e. anyone owner either individually or in a partnership) who have accepted the highest number of horses by applying one or more of the following criteria in that order:-

- (i) Preference of elimination submitted by the Owner/Trainer if any.
- (ii) Descending order of the number of starts of the horses during the meeting.
- (iii) In case of a tie, lots will be drawn.

This process will be continued till the required number of horses are eliminated.

- (c) if the acceptors exceed 15 but not more than 24 the race will be divided into two divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (d) if the acceptors exceed 24 but not more than 30, then the acceptors in excess of 24 will be eliminated as per the procedure detailed above and the race will be divided into two divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (e) if the acceptors exceed 30 but not more than 36 the race will be divided into three divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (f) if the acceptors exceed 36, then the acceptors in excess of 36 will be eliminated as per the procedure detailed above and the race will be divided into three divisions at the option of the Stewards.
- (g) However, on days when the following races are run the number of acceptors will be permitted up to a maximum of fifteen in all ordinary races.
 - (i) Fillies Championship Stakes (Grade I)
 - (ii) Colts Championship Stakes (Grade I)
 - (iii) Kingfisher Ultra Derby Bangalore (Grade I)
 - (iv) Bangalore St.Leger (Grade II)
 - (v) Governor's Cup (Grade III)

Horses in excess of fifteen will be eliminated as per the procedure detailed under 11(a) & 11(b).

- (h) If in a Sweepstakes race, the number of acceptors exceed 18, the additional acceptors will be rejected by eliminating the

horses who have earned the lowest aggregate stakes after 31st March, 2015. In case of a tie, rejection shall be by drawing lots. The entry money, forfeits and any other contributions in respect of the horses eliminated will be fully refunded.

- (i) Owners and Trainers who have accepted more than one horse in a race, may exercise their priority of elimination in the prescribed form and the same should be lodged in the scratching box before the time of scratchings for that day.
 - (j) Service charges will not be levied in respect of the horses eliminated.
 - (k) (i) A horse eliminated from a race shall not be excluded by elimination, when it has been accepted the next time.
 - (ii) In case a race is declared void owing to paucity of acceptors, horses who have accepted in that race would be deemed to have been eliminated from that race and such horses also shall not be excluded by elimination when they accept next time.
 - (iii) In case a race is cancelled after acceptances, horses who have accepted in that race would be deemed to have been eliminated from that race and such horses also shall not be excluded by elimination when they accept the next time.
 - (l) In case a horse is "left in" in a race where additional acceptors are likely to be eliminated the same horse may be "left in" for any other race on the same day or any other day for which the scratchings are at the same time on the same day with a note on the scratching form that it will be effective if the said horse is not eliminated from the other race for which the additional acceptors are likely to be eliminated. Similarly a horse may be "left in" in a race with a note on the scratching form that it will be effective if the race in question is not divided.
 - (m) If any other condition not stipulated in Clause (l) above is attached to the scratching, such condition shall be ignored.
12. The Stewards reserve the right to refuse an entry or to cancel an accepted entry at any stage without assigning a reason.
13. (a) The Stewards reserve the right to amend or to alter the conditions of any race at any time before the Entry closes and to alter the name of any race after the closing of Entries and to increase the advertised Stakes for any race prior to Final Forfeits/ Scratchings.

- (b) The Stewards reserve the right to indicate any race/s to be ridden by Indian Jockeys only at the time of the publication of acceptances.
14. In all Handicaps the lowest weight to be carried shall not be less than 50 Kgs. excluding the Allowance which a Jockey may claim, if applicable. However, the Handicaps may be framed down to weights below 50 Kgs.
15. Winner of a race after publication of weights in a handicap race shall carry 5 Kgs. extra.
16. (a) Minimum top weight in a Handicap race will be 60 Kgs. Unless otherwise specified if the highest weight an acceptor has to carry is less than 60 Kgs. it shall be raised to 60 Kgs. and the other weights shall be raised equally.
- (b) Unless otherwise specified, if the highest weight an Acceptor has to carry in a Terms race is less than 55 Kgs. it shall be raised to 55 Kgs. and the other weights shall be raised equally.
- (c) Unless otherwise specified, Foreign horses will carry 7.5 Kgs. more than the weights published in all terms race.
17. No horse shall carry more than 2 Kgs. overweight in any race, except with the permission of the Stewards if the horse is ridden by a Jockey who is either not entitled to claim an Allowance or cannot claim an Allowance under the Conditions of the race. However, in case a horse is ridden by a Jockey claiming an Allowance it shall not carry, except with the permission of the Stewards, more than 2 Kgs. in excess of the weight which it would have carried if the Jockey in question had claimed in full the allowance to which he was entitled. Such permission must be obtained before the Starting Declaration box for such race is opened.
18. In Terms Races without penalties, the weights to be carried by the horses will be published in the Handicaps. However, in Terms Races with penalties, the weights to be carried by the horses will be published directly in the Acceptances.
19. Unless otherwise specified, Starting Declarations to be made by the Owner, Trainer or the Authorised Agent, in respect of all horses for all the races must be placed in the boxes set apart for each race, not later than 10 a.m. on the day prior to the race day. The Declaration must be in writing on an official form and must state

- the name of the race, the name of the horse, weight to be carried, the name of the Jockey and must be accompanied by the Jockey's fee for a losing mount, if not already paid, and any other fees due. It shall also state if the horse is running shod or unshod; if the former, it shall state the description of shoes, plates or Tips used. Omissions or errors in the Starting Declaration, will render the Owner, Trainer or the Authorised Agent making it, liable to a fine at the discretion of the Stewards.
20. (a) Indian Jockeys below 25 years of age and apprentices shall be entitled to claim the following allowances in any handicap flat race.

- No allowance can be claimed after having ridden 40 winners or attaining the age of 25 years whichever is earlier. Notwithstanding the above, a jockey reaching the specified limit of wins as stated above will still be entitled for the allowance originally declared provided the betting for such a race has already opened.
- (b) No rider shall ride in any race, unless he is wearing a Skull Cap of a pattern approved by the Stewards.
21. Horses will not be allowed to be led down to the start in advance of the remainder of the field except in very exceptional circumstances, which must be explained to the satisfaction of the Stewards in writing, at least one clear day before the date on which the horse is due to start.
22. Colours must be declared with Entries unless already registered under B.T.C. Rules. Where colours are not registered a declaration must be made of the colours to be used at or prior to the time for closing of Forfeits for that day, otherwise a fine may be imposed. If there be more than one horse of any one Owner left in, in a race, a different coloured cap must be declared for each horse. Every person running a horse in colours other than those registered or declared as above, may be fined.

In the event of a person being unable to run a horse in colours as declared in the official race card, the Jockey will wear "All Black". A set of these colours may be obtained from the Clerk of the Scales.

23. (a) An Owner's pass, which is not transferable, will be issued for the Meeting to those whose horses are entered. Only one Owner's pass will be given to Joint Owners.
- (b) Trainers and Jockeys must obtain their Passes from the Office, without which they will not be permitted to enter the enclosures.
- (c) Rules in connection with the issue of Passes to Riding Boys, Servants, Farriers and Syces, may be obtained from the Office. Applications for all Passes should be made during working hours on non-race days.
